POPE DUAL ENROLLMENT DEADLINES

Pope sets internal priority deadlines that are EARLIER than the college application deadlines. College course registration often begins before the college deadlines so applying earlier provides a better* chance of getting desired courses.

The Pope Priority Deadline is:

March 1

If the college DE deadline is earlier than March 1, we *strongly* recommend completing the process AT LEAST ONE MONTH PRIOR to the college deadline.

Dual Enrollment, by its nature, places much responsibility on the student. Therefore, it is the **student's** responsibility to ensure that **all steps** are followed accurately and on time. Please check off steps as they are completed.

- BOTH student and parent: **Attend the Pope Dual Enrollment (DE) Information Night OR watch the replay video** at <http://tinyurl.com/popedepage>. This is **mandatory** for all interested in DE. Additional information meetings, such as the CCSD Summit and KSU DE Information Sessions, do not replace this requirement but serve as supplements to the Pope specific information.
 - It is the student's responsibility to **research college requirements** both for DE admissions and college admissions, impact to GPA/HOPE, impact on rigor as viewed by colleges, day-to-day logistics, course transferability, etc.
 - Take the SAT/ACT/Accuplacer** and **submit** scores (and any desired AP scores) to the college(s) of your choice.
 - SAT: www.collegeboard.org
 - ACT: www.actstudent.org
 - Accuplacer: schedule directly with Chatt Tech
 - Send AP scores to exempt intro courses
- FALL testing recommended to meet Pope Priority Deadline!**
- Submit the DE application** to the college (found on college website).
 - Submit official HS transcript** to college (\$2). Student - request this in the Pope Counseling office. (Technical colleges, such as Chattahoochee Tech, do not require a transcript for admission)
 - After the above steps have been completed, **email your counselor to request a Counselor DE Advisement Meeting**. We will email you required documents to complete and bring to the meeting. We will discuss graduation requirements, desired DE classes, complete Student Participation Agreement and CCSD Local School Agreement, and more. We reserve the right to reschedule the meeting if steps above are not completed before the meeting.
- All steps above this line must be completed according to the **Pope Priority Deadline.**


- Submit DE funding application on www.gafutures.org.
 - Submit completed Student Participation Agreement to college.
 - Receive email acceptance from college (student).
 - Register for and attend advisement/orientation at college ASAP (instructions will arrive via email).
 - Register for classes at college ASAP.
 - Email a PDF of your detailed schedule to your counselor ASAP, but **no later than the last day of school.**
 - Send any remaining documents to college (immunization, verification of lawful presence, etc.).

Accuplacer: 237 Reading, 4 WritePlacer, 269 Math, 520 Total Score (R+WP+M)

ACT: 20 (Min 18 English, 18 Math)

Application Deadlines: Applicants can ONLY begin in the fall semester. Continuing students are eligible for summer.

Final Fall Deadline: ~~March 27~~ Please follow Pope priority deadlines as described above (Feb 27)
